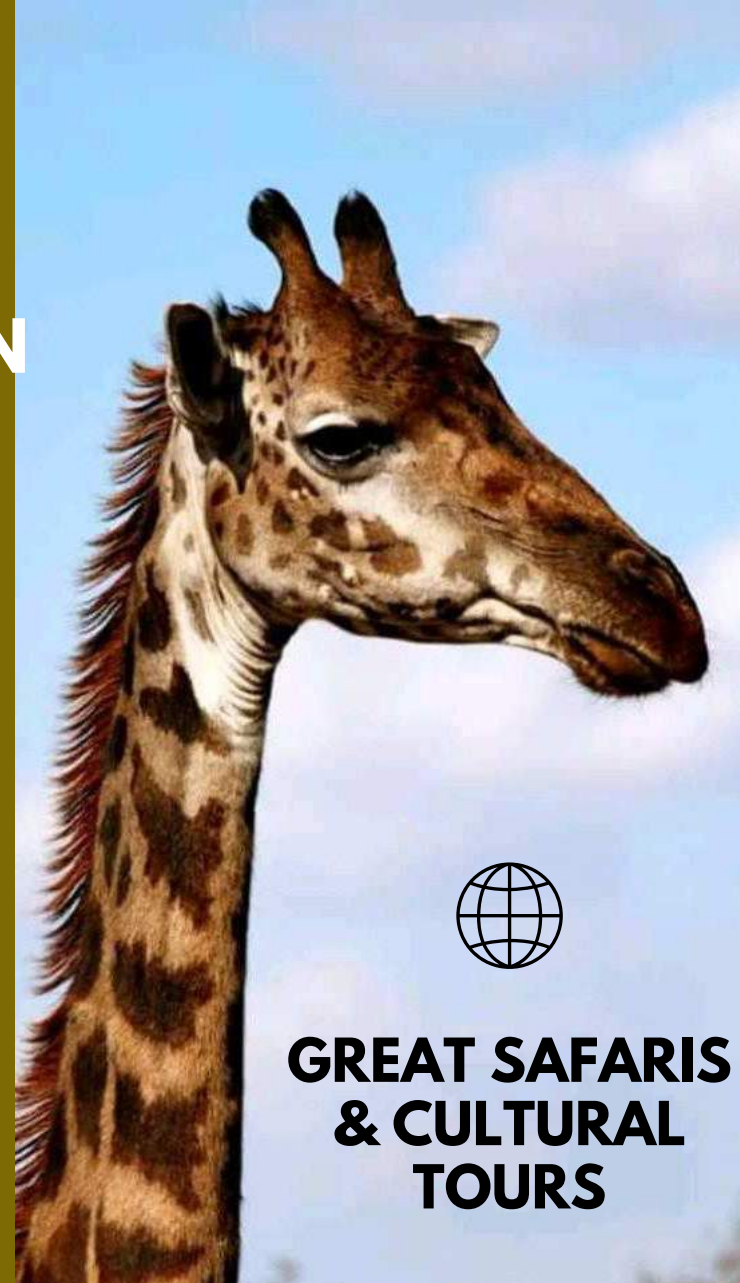

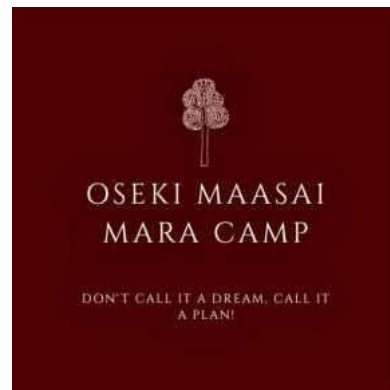

THE HIKE

We will hike up Leruk hill with the goal of encountering elephants and other wildlife on foot. The hill is 2.025 meter high and part of Siana Nonservation Park, next to the Masai Mara National Park. Upon requests, we can also organise a safari in Siana Conservation Park. We can also combine the hike with a safari in Siana Conservation Park. Contact us for Siana Conservation park levies.

ELEPHANT HIKE WITH MAASAI WARRIORS

How do we do?

During this hike we will climb up Leruk hill which promises you a breathtaking view over the Mara. During this hike there is a 70% procent chance to view wild elephant on foot, either down in the valley or during your hike up the hill. Expect to be up the hill in about 30 - 45 minutes. The hike is best to be done in the morning to not miss out on elephant activity. We can arrange a picknick lunch on the top of the mountain.

Rules & regulations

Please wear good hiking shoes & clothing and listen to the guides at all time. Please keep your noise down and never, ever run. The calmer you are the better. Our guides and rangers are there to support you during your walk up and to indulge you with Maasai knowledge and exciting stories. We are there to keep you safe.

The Environment

During the hike the warriors will also teach you how to track wild elephants on foot and other wildlife. Expect to view giraffe, zebra and baboons during the hike, wonderfull birds and unique wild flowers. The hike is not to difficult and medium in intensity.

BUSH WALK WITH BOW & ARROW CLASS

Birds, wild flowers, scrubs & trees

We happily teach you how to recognise the beautiful birds, flowers and trees in the area. We also explain the medical uses of the plants and their meaning in Maasai culture. It is an experience that matches all ages and really has it's focus on nature. You might encounter giraffes, zebras or baboons on your walk. Please wear suitable walking shoes & clothes, and no jewellery.

Track & sign

This walk is all about the little things. Have you ever wondered about the small big 5? or how to track a lion on foot? During this walk the warriors teach you what to look out for in the bush and how to track wild animals on foot.

Bow & arrow class & spear throwing

During our walk, we teach you how to throw a Maasai spear and/or to shoot with a bow and arrow under the guidance of a real Maasai warrior who has spent about 3 years training in the bush in order to learn how to survive and protect the community from any outside dangers.

HERD CATTLE WITH KENYA'S MAASAI

Maasai tradition

The Maasai herding and cattle experience is perfect for families, couples, single travellers or groups of friends. It is a unique experience set up together with Airbnb. With this experience, we hope to support the Maasai pastoralists & herders with their cattle and families. Cattle is very important for the Maasai, as it provides a reliable form of income, used for meat and milk but also for clothing, decoration, masks etc.

A Personal Maasai guide

During this experience you will have your own guide who will help you with translations. You will learn how to keep the cattle together, treat their (possible) injuries in a traditional way and learn how to milk a cow or goat.

If there is an opportunity, we invite a local vet over to come help or we can walk towards the market where you can see where new cattle is being bought and sold. It is truly a unique experience and it allows you to really spend time with the local people. You will also be invited over in their homestead for a nice cup of tea or coffee to really blend in in the Maasai lifestyle.

Travel tip: Join in on one of our activities to help support the community and to experience real Maasai culture.

THE LIFE OF THE MAASAI

The life of the Masai tribe of Kenya and Tanzania revolves around cattle. Virtually all social roles and status derive from the relationship of individuals with the amount of cattle owned.

If you like, you can participate in a mini beadwork class during your visit to the Maasai village. You may bring your work of art along to home to show what kind of talented artist you are! We will make sure that we support the ladies with their beadwork through your kind visit.



MAASAI VILLAGE VISIT

Maasai Dancing & Singing

The Maasai will welcome you with their traditional songs and dances and guide you through their village. We like to make the visit as personal and sometimes, one of the locals will invite you over for a cup of tea in one of their homes. Expect to participate in dancing and experience real Maasai culture!

The Market & the local Blacksmith

During your visit you will get the chance to visit the Maasai market to buy yourself some souvenirs and to visit the local blacksmith who will show you his artwork. Expect a guided tour through the village whereby the houses and way of life through time in Maasai land will be explained.

MAASAI VILLAGE STAY

The Maasai have a basic lifestyle of nomadic origin in semi-permanent houses made out of cow dung, mud, water, twigs and since recent years a bit of cement. The village is the heart of the people where everyone gathers at night for storytelling and dinner. Expect to spend the day like a real Maasai man or lady, engaging in their daily activities in order to understand the culture better whilst learning how to go back to basics!

P.S. There will be a toilet & shower available.

One says that people who have a fear of heights, won't have this during a balloon flight as it looks like you are close to the ground. The pilots in the Mara are highly trained and will do everything to make sure you will experience a safe trip with a breathtaking view!

Enjoy a wide variety of experiences that make the Masai Mara beautiful.

HOT AIR BALLOON

YOUR DREAM TRIP

On the date of your hot air balloon flight, the balloon operating company shall collect you from your safari lodge/ tented camp in one of their custom safari jeep at around 5AM for a drive to the hot air balloon launch. Arrive at the launch site by 6AM, here you can watch the balloons being prepared for take-off as you enjoy a cup of Kenyan tea or coffee

Your balloon pilot, will in the meantime give you a safety briefing as well as explain your expectations during the flight. At the Launch site-there are basic toilet facilities available. Just before sunrise, at approximately 6:30AM, you shall board the balloon basket.

BALLOONING

The balloon flight lasts approximately one hour and this also depends on prevailing wind conditions, landing is between 7:30 and 7:45AM. Upon landing, and as part of this unique adventure-you may observe the complete deflation of the balloon. You shall then be transported to a place for your breakfast. Breakfast is usually set up on the savannah plains of the Masai Mara, traditionally under the shade of a lonely acacia tree.

THE RATES

The Rates are \$450 per person and involves pick up and drop off, a mini safari, the Hot Air Balloon flight and a luxury breakfast with champagne accompanied by a certificate that shows you have been flying above the air.

HOW TO HELP

Maasai local school

We like to help the local school wherever we can, with donations of books and games or pencils. If you like, you can join in on a class (Please book beforehand) or play football with the children outside. They are happy to show you around!

Maasai local hospital

The Maasai local hospital is very basic. We hope that through many visits of travellers around the world that we can help to build up to hospital step for step. Education is key, do you happen to have a medical background? Maybe you could help with some tips to create a better future for the Maasai peoples to make their lives a bit more certain!

Maasai local church

The church is only open on a Sunday. Every Sunday all the people come together from far to talk and sing together. A session can take up to 3 hours and will involve lots of singing and dancing. It's a total different experience than you will encounter at home, but the peoples heart lies in singing and dancing.

MAASAI COOKING CLASS

Traditional Maasai Cooking class

There are six main ingredients that go into a Maasai diet, where the cattle play a major role again. These ingredients are: milk, meat, blood, fat, honey and the bark of some trees.

Milk has a prominent role in the traditional Maasai diet, since it is an integral part of almost every meal of Maasai shepherds; it is drunk when fresh, curdled, mixed with tea or in the form of butter; the latter is used to feed children during the period of their growth.

The cows are hardly ever slaughtered and eaten, they are usually milked and their blood removed, they are killed only on special occasions, the wealth of a Maasai man is measured by the number of head of cattle he possesses, so meat is never lacking for celebrations.

During this cooking class, we will exchange the different cooking styles, focussed on Maasai cooking and bush style cooking. The Maasai love to learn new cooking styles so if you have a good recipe, please bring it along so we can try it out together!

TRADITIONAL FOOD

Expect to sit around the fireplace at night just when a cow, sheep or goat has been freshly slaughtered for you accompanied with ugali, spinach, tomatoes, rice and chapati. The food is traditionally being made on a jikoni.

Create your own experience

Enjoy Maasai food made by locals around the campfire accompanied by traditional songs, games and storytelling.

FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation

The accommodation is basic and simple and run by local Maasai peoples. We provide a basic bathroom with hot shower and toilet for every safaritent. The safaritents are big and can hold up to 4 people.

Low season: \$55,- per person per night.

High season: \$65,- / \$75,- per person per night.

Children: \$35,- per child per night.

Camping

For \$15,- a night per person we can offer you a spot on our camping place just 10 minutes away from the Masai Mara National Reserve and budget-friendly. Please bring along your own tent. You can make use of a hot shower & toilet facilities.

DRINKS

We offer alcohol at an extra rate. We include full board during your stay in the rate which includes breakfast, lunch, dinner and wi-fi. The drinks that are free are juice, water, tea and coffee.

Vegetarian, vegan or allergies?

Even though traditional Maasai food involves a lot of meat we can totally offer you a meat free sish according to your wishes. If you are allergic to something, please tell us beforehand.
